Students learn the building science of how a house works as a system in order to generate HERS Ratings for new construction or comprehensive Energy Audits for existing homes. Successful completion of this class will enable you to:

- Provide certified HERS ratings and verification for ENERGY STAR New Homes and LEED® for Homes
- Participate in 2009/2012 IECC verification for the numerous building departments
- Create financial documentation for Energy Efficient Mortgages (EEM)
- Assist home builders and architects in designing and building energy efficient homes
- Perform comprehensive home energy audits/assessments and generate reports
- Become a licensed Energy Auditor by Nevada's Department of Business and Industry Real Estate Division

Students taking Energy Conservation Group's RESNET HERS Rater training will be properly prepared to pass RESNET's HERS Rater, Combustion and Work Scope written exams as well as the ResCaz online CAZ simulation exam.

Two probationary HERS Ratings will be completed to assist your [Rater Provider](#) in becoming a certified HERS Rater. After this class you will have the basics to diagnose and provide recommended improvements. Companies employing such trained and certified individuals know they will experience fewer call backs and enjoy an increased rate of referrals from satisfied home builders and home owners. Existing homeowners can expect that their energy bills will be reduced, while improving comfort and health when implementing recommended and verified measures.

This six day course includes both classroom and hands-on field training. (50 hours). Students will learn to use REM/Rate energy modeling software.

Student requirements: Students must know basic construction terminology, capable of calculating areas, volumes and using simple algebraic equations. We require passing our [basic skills assessment](#) before registering. To maximize your success, we recommend reading Residential Energy (Kriger & Dorsi) before class which is provided after registering.

Prerequisites for RESNET HERS Rater Training:

- Complete and pass math [skills assessment test](#) before start of class
- Read "Residential Energy" by Krigger and Dorsi prior to class (pick up after payment is made)
- Prepared to study 1-3 hours nightly
- Capable of navigating an attic and/or crawlspace
- Laptop computer for written exam and ResCaz simulation software
- Non programmable calculator, clipboard, 25' tape measure, flashlight for field training
